



TUVALU MONTHLY AND SEASONAL OUTLOOK May to July 2023

SUMMARY

- The ENSO outlook is currently Neutral
- Rainfall outlook for Tuvalu predicted above normal for Tuvalu group during May 2023
- For May to July season, above normal rainfall is likely across the northern group and near normal across the central and southern groups
- Monthly seasonal outlook for May and May to July for maximum and minimum temperatures shows above normal very likely for the group of Tuvalu

EI-NINO SOUTHERN OSCILLATION (ENSO)




The El Niño-Southern Oscillation (ENSO) is currently neutral (neither La Niña nor El Niño). Oceanic and atmospheric indicators for the tropical Pacific Ocean are at neutral ENSO levels. However, there are some

signs El Niño may form later in the year. Therefore, the ENSO Outlook is at El Niño WATCH. This means there is approximately a 50% chance of El Niño in 2023.

El-Nino condition will increase the chance of rainfall and cyclones in the region.


RAINFALL OUTLOOK

The monthly rainfall outlook for May shows above normal is very likely for the group of Tuvalu


MAY TO JULY 2023



For the coming season May to July shows near normal is very likely for the central and southern groups; and above normal for the northern group


AIR TEMPERATURE OUTLOOK

Monthly outlook for May shows above normal very likely for the group of Tuvalu


MAY TO JULY 2022: MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE



Seasonal outlook for May to July shows above normal very likely for the group of Tuvalu


AIR TEMPERATURE OUTLOOK
