

CLIMATE SUMMARY

July 2025



WEATHER PATTERNS

During July, southeast trade winds tend to be stronger, therefore Tuvalu Meteorological Service issued two Strong wind warnings at the beginning of the month. The South Pacific Convergence Zone (SPCZ) which is one of the sub climate driver lies further south of Tuvalu. This could have led to a fewer troughs to passed over our area of responsibility during that period. Therefore, fewer troughs could have led all the stations to experience less total rainfall compared to the previous month. Based on observations from all stations, Nanumea recorded the highest total amount of rainfall, totaling 266.1 mm.
