- "La Nina Watch continuing"
- Below normal to Normal rainfall for the whole group of Tuvalu during August and August to October.
- Maximum and Minimum temperatures during August and August to October are likely to be above normal across the country.


EI-NINO SOUTHERN OSCILLATION (ENSO)



- Sea Surface Temperatures in the Central Pacific have been cooling .
- Climate models suggests that Sea Surface Temperatures in the central tropical pacific are likely to continue to cool for at least the next two months.
- The Bureau's ENSO Outlook is at La Nina Watch due to early signs that an event may form in the Pacific Ocean later in 2024.


RAINFALL OUTLOOK

The rainfall for August is likely to be near-normal around the Northern and Central Groups, while the Southern Group is likely or very likely to have above normal, except at Niulakita where near-normal is likely.


August to October 2024




The rainfall for August to October is likely or very likely to below normal around the Northern group and near normal in central group including Funafuti. In the Sothern group is likely to be above normal.

Monthly and Seasonal Minimum Temperature




August minimum temperature is very likely to be above normal across the whole group of Tuvalu.




August to October minimum temperature are very likely to be above normal over Tuvalu.
