

- "The El Nino-Southern Oscillation (ENSO) is neutral"
- The rainfall outlook generally indicates near normal most likely in May to July.
- Maximum and Minimum temperatures during May and May to July 2025 are most likely to be above normal.


EI-NINO SOUTHERN OSCILLATION



- Global Sea Surface Temperatures remained substantially above average.
- The Bureau's models forecasts neutral ENSO conditions (neither El Niño nor La Niña) until at least
 August. This is consistent with all surveyed international models.


RAINFALL OUTLOOK

The rainfall for May 2025 is likely to be nearnormal over Tuvalu.


MAY TO JULY 2025




The rainfall for May to July 2025 are likely to be near normal across the country.

Monthly and Seasonal Minimum Temperature




May 2025, minimum temperature is very likely to be above normal across the whole group of Tuvalu.




May to July 2025, minimum temperature are very likely to be above normal over Tuvalu.
