SUMMARY

- El Niño ALERT continues, with EL Nino development likely during spring.
- The rainfall for October and for October to December is likely or very likely to be above normal over Tuvalu. .
- Maximum and minimum temperatures during October and averaged over October to December are likely or very likely to be above normal over Tuvalu.


EI-NINO SOUTHERN OS-CILLATION (ENSO)



- The ENSO Outlook remains at El Niño Alert, with El Niño development likely during the months of southern spring (September, October and November).
- Sea surface temperatures (SSTs) in the tropical Pacific are exceeding El Niño thresholds, with climate models indicating this is likely to continue at least through to early 2024.
- The 90-day Southern Oscillation Index (SOI) is currently -7, exceeding El Niño thresholds. Trade winds for August 2023 were slightly weaker than average across the Pacific for the first time since January 2020.


RAINFALL OUTLOOK

Rainfall for October is likely or very likely to be above normal across the country.


OCTOBER TO DECEMBER 2023




The rainfall for October to December is likely or very likely to be above normal over Tuvalu.

Monthly and Seasonal Minimum Temperature




October minimum temperature is likely or very likely to be above normal.




October to December minimum tempreature are likely to be above normal over Tuvalu.
