## **WEATHER PATTERNS**

El Nino continued to impact the Pacific region. Both MJO and South Pacific Convergence zone started to weaken due to the tropical low that located near Tonga and moved off to the southeast and it take much of SPCZ energy. Nevertheless, a branch of a Convergence Zone with a trough lingered over Tuvalu and Tokelau on the 13th of March. Thus, this branch associated with clouds and rain affected the whole group. Therefore, all stations were experiencing heavy rainfall, but Nanumea recorded the highest daily rainfall of 85.3 mm. While, Nui recorded the highest total rainfall of the month of about 391.5 mm.
